<u>A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL</u> <u>AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DUNWOODY AND DEKALB COUNTY FOR</u> <u>POLICE SERVICES</u>

- WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are the governing authority of the City of Dunwoody; and
