AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23 OF THE CITY OF DUNWOODY CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CREATING STREET LIGHT DISTRICTS

- WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody has heretofore adopted an ordinance for Streets and Sidewalks, as set forth in Chapter 23 of the Code of the City of Dunwoody (the "Code"); and
- WHEREAS, the provisions of the Streets and Sidewalks Ordinance currently do not include any provisions for establishment and maintenance of street lights in the City's Right-of-Way; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it may be appropriate to amend the ordinance to establish Street Light Districts and provide for a policy for its creation and maintenance.

THEREFORE, Mayor and City Council of the City of Dunwoody hereby ordain:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Streets and Sidewalks ordinance, Chapter 23 of the City of Dunwoody Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended by adding a new Article VI to read as follows:

Article VI: Street Light Districts

Section 1: Program Established

There is established a Street Light District program whereby eligible residential areas may petition the City to authorize installation of street lights within their neighborhood. The Public Works Department shall create and maintain a policy for establishment of a Street Light District.

Section 2: Council Approval

Prior to the installation of any street lights, the City Council shall approve by Resolution the establishment of each such District, pursuant to the policy created by the Public Works Department.

Section 2: This Amendment shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and incorporated into the Code of the City of Dunwoody, Georgia. This Amendment hereby repeals any and all conflicting ordinances and amendments.
