Dear Kevin,

As per our discussions, Pond has prepared a set of additional service cost estimates to conduct four (4) subsequent subarea public involvement meetings and two (2) steering committee meetings. These additions reflect a change to the Participation Plan approved by City Council (see attached schedule) to include these meetings. These will augment the originally defined "themed" meetings, and, if understood correctly, will be conducted in a similar format as the September 24th meeting. Costs are defined below.

The current contract expires December 31, 2009. You requested scheduling public hearings by the end of February 2010 for transmittal to ARC/DCA. As DCA requires a 60-day review period prior to adoption, the earliest the City of Dunwoody would be able to adopt the Comprehensive Plan is May 2010. We suggest the contract be extended to July 1, 2010 in order to ensure sufficient time to allow the City to incorporate any recommendations from ARC and DCA,.

The additional services incorporate the preparation, production, staffing meetings, and processing of results. The costs are based upon estimated hours multiplied by the blended hourly rate of \$115 an hour that was included in our contract for additional services, plus direct costs (plotted maps, mileage etc).

Scope of Work:

Four (4) Community Informational Meetings:

Objective: Conduct an orientation to the process, conduct a presentation focused on the sub area and provide opportunity for input (comments) regarding recommended policies and vision for character areas and future development.

Format: Presentation with questions and answer format. Presentations will focus on the subarea and include additional techniques such as design preference surveys, as directed by Staff with input by Steering Committee.

Resources: 2 facilitators, preparation and consolidating results: \$3,500

Two (2) additional **Steering Committee Meetings**:

Objective: Provide additional opportunity to prepare policies and implementation program and make final recommendations for City Council consideration.

Format: Working meeting refining preliminary draft documents

Resources: Facilitator, preparation and consolidating results: \$1,000 evening

Fee Schedule

4 Community Meetings

\$3,500 x 4 = \$14,000

2 Steering Committee Meetings:

 $1,000 \times 2 = 2,000$
