- ITEM: Consideration of Approval of the contract to construct Dunwoody Club Drive LARP Paving and the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Sandy Springs and the City of Dunwoody.

We received bids from qualified contractors to perform the LARP paving of Dunwoody Club Drive from east of Spalding Drive to Mount Vernon Road. A total of eight bids were received, in alphabetical order they were:

- Allied paving Contractors \$447,473.00
- Atlanta Paving and Concrete \$615,376.00
- Baldwin Paving \$387,858.31
- Blount Construction \$490,945.00
- Butch Thompson Enterprises \$426,644.27
- CW Matthews Contracting \$419,785.07
- ER Snell Contracting \$536,432.00
- Stewart Brothers \$546,965.70

The bids returned well within budget. Public Works Department staff recommends the award of the contract to the low bidder, Baldwin Paving, contingent on the signing of an Inter-Governmental Agreement with the City of Dunwoody to pay for its half of the project costs.
