#### **Project Description**

## Hammond Drive Widening and Multi-modal Improvements

### GA 400 to Ashford Dunwoody Road

Purpose: Once the new one-half diamond interchange at GA 400 and Hammond Drive is operational the traffic patterns in the Perimeter CID's are anticipated to adjust to the convenience of this much anticipated transportation improvement. Much of the increased traffic patterns are anticipated to impact existing Hammond Drive from GA 400 to the east to Ashford Dunwoody Road. Properties abutting or in near proximity to this same stretch of Hammond Drive are already entitled to be developed into dense mixed use developments that will further increase traffic pressure on existing Hammond Drive. The capacity of Hammond Drive is near capacity now and will be exceeded once these two activities take place.

Description: Existing Hammond Drive is predominately a 4 lanes undivided facility (2 through lanes in each direction) with single left turn lanes and some right turn lanes at the major intersections of Peachtree Dunwoody Road, Perimeter Center Parkway and Ashford Dunwoody Road. Existing sidewalks of varying widths exist along one or both sides of Hammond Drive within limits of the proposed improvements. No bike lanes exist within the limits of proposed improvements; however existing bike lanes exist on Perimeter Center Parkway. Limited or no streetscape improvements exist within the limits of improvements. The Dunwoody MARTA Rail Station is positioned a the northeast corner of Hammond Drive and Perimeter Center Parkway creating a multi-modal transportation opportunity and a concentration of pedestrian, bicycle, bus, shuttle, rail and vehicle circulation

Hammond Drive is proposed to be widened from 4 to 6 through lanes from GA 400 to Ashford Dunwoody Road a distance of 1.2 miles. Dual left turn lanes are proposed on all four approaches to the Peachtree Dunwoody intersection and associated traffic signal improvements. The intersection of Perimeter Center Parkway is anticipated have dual left turn lanes at the Hammond Drive approaches and single left turn lanes on the other 2 approaches and associated traffic signal improvements. The laneage at the intersection of Ashford Dunwoody Drive is anticipated to remain similar to existing conditions. Bike lanes and streetscape improvements that comply with the Perimeter CID standards will extend the full length of the proposed improvements.
