Subject: Discussion of 2013 Paving Plans

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Discussion of 2013 Paving Plans

BACKGROUND

Since the 2013 paving list was approved by Council this past December, Public Works has received new information that impacts the list of streets planned for paving in 2013. A brief discussion of each item and its effect on the paving plan is provided below.

Spalding Drive Paving and Bike Lanes

Last year preliminary design was completed to add bike lanes as part of the repaving of Spalding Drive in accordance with the City's adopted transportation plan. The paving was deferred to 2013 when it was determined that right of way would be needed to complete the bike lanes. Public Works has subsequently discussed the project with the property owner from whom the City would need to acquire right of way and the owner is not interested in providing the right of way. Considering that Sandy Springs has no intentions of adding bike lanes on its section of Spalding in the foreseeable future, staff recommends proceeding with resurfacing without bike lanes at this time. A sidewalk on the east side of Spalding between Spender Trace and Coronation Drive is recommended as a future project.

Chamblee Dunwoody and Mount Vernon Paving-Dunwoody Village

Public Works has been in discussions with DeKalb County Watershed Management to coordinate City projects with County plans to replace aging water mains. The County has recently identified lines for replacement under the sections of Chamblee Dunwoody Road and Mount Vernon Road that the City intended to pave this year. However, they have just begun design work and will not have the construction completed in time for the City's paving this summer. **Staff recommends deferring paving on these segments to allow the County time to replace the mains.** The expectation would be that the County could have the main replaced in time for paving in 2014. In the interim, the City could include additional pavement patching in this year's paving contract to address problem areas.



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Chamblee Dunwoody Cambridge to Valley View bicycle and pedestrian improvements

This project was designed and bid last year then deferred to await a decision on funding from the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC). The City was ultimately successful in securing \$640,000 from ARC for this project but recently learned that the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) would be managing the project and that the timeline to gain approval and begin construction would likely be at least 18 to 24 months.

In a related effort, the City also applied for ARC funding to begin preliminary planning for the bicycle, pedestrian and streetscape for the remainder of Chamblee Dunwoody Road in accordance with the City's master plan recommendations. This application was not selected by ARC but in subsequent discussions with ARC staff they have suggested that the City consider allocating a portion of the \$640,000 to fund design of the entire corridor with the balance going towards construction.

There would be several benefits to this approach:

- 1. The various improvements recommend along the corridor could be planned and designed in a cohesive and comprehensive manner.
- 2. Once the design was completed, the City would be well-positioned for future funding opportunities through ARC and GDOT. Construction could be divided into several phases.
- 3. The City would only have to fund 20% of the design costs.

The primary disadvantage would be the duration and additional requirements associated with receiving federal funds. There is also the potential that some redesign work would be necessary if the construction were phased with long lapses in time occurring between design and construction of later phases of the project.

Regardless of how the ARC money is allocated, staff recommends deferral of this segment for at least one year to allow for DeKalb to replace the water main underneath the roadway. Staff further suggests accepting ARC's offer to reallocate a portion of the \$640,000 to complete design of improvements for the entire Chamblee Dunwoody corridor.

Based on these recommendations, a revised 2013 paving plan is attached. The streets recommended to replace Chamblee Dunwoody and Mount Vernon were selected from the 5-year plan based on the following considerations:

- 1. Geographic relation to other streets in the plan
- 2. Whether the street is underlain by water lines that need to be replaced
- 3. The ease with which the non-neighborhood streets could be retrofitted with bike lanes in accordance with the City's Complete Street Policy

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends proceeding with the revised list of streets for paving in 2013.
