Subject: **Discussion of On-Street Parking on Vermack Road at Dunwoody High School**

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Discussion of On-Street Parking on Vermack Road at Dunwoody High School

BACKGROUND

The city recently resurfaced Vermack Road in the vicinity of Dunwoody High School and is preparing to place new pavement markings. Staff has recently observed that cars are parked on the street in front of the school more frequently than in past years. According to the school Principal, enrollment is up and the number of school parking passes was limited this school year. The street is wide enough to accommodate parallel parking adjacent to the school, and parking is not prohibited though spaces are not designated with pavement marking.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff's recommendation is to narrow the lanes on Vermack Road to 10 feet as they are south of Womack, allow a space for bicycles and mark parallel parking spaces adjacent to the high school.
