





Looking Ahead

Potential Problems and Challenges

- Parking
 - At the current building, there are roughly 40 parking spaces.
- Traffic
 - At AM and PM rush hours, Roberts Drive tends to experience mild (and sometimes severe) traffic jams.
- Noise and Neighborhoods
 - The Austin site is circled by one neighborhood and is across the street from two more.
 - Proximity to neighborhoods is not necessarily a drawback, however.
- Flooding
 - Much of the proposed park area is prone to flooding

What We're Excited About!

- Access to more of the Dunwoody community
 - Entirely different council district than Brook Run Park
 - Proximity to new neighborhoods, churches, schools, commercial areas
- Features attract a variety of ages and interests
 - Addition of food truck nights and walking trails at Brook Run
