Subject: Approval of Unit Price Contracts for Geotechnical

Engineering, Construction Materials Testing, and

Environmental Services

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Approval of unit price contracts with three firms to provide geotechnical engineering, construction materials testing, and environmental services as needed in support of city construction projects.

BACKGROUND

The city has used a variety of on-call, unit price contracts to engage qualified contractors to efficiently complete many stormwater and sidewalk projects. Under this type of unit price agreement, each project is negotiated with one of the selected contractors based on the estimated quantities and the contract unit prices for each item. Having gone through a prequalification process each contractor will have a good understanding of the city's expectations for quality and promptness required for each project.

The types of services to be provided under the contract presented herein include: soil testing to provide building foundation and pavement recommendations; environmental sampling and analysis for hazardous materials in soil, water and building materials; and quality control testing of soil, concrete and asphalt. A request for qualifications for this contract was publically advertised and eight proposals were received. The proposals were evaluated based on qualifications, the proposed personnel for the project and the contractor's experience with similar projects. Based on these considerations, the top three ranked firms were determined to be the most responsive to the city's request for qualifications and were asked to submit a schedule of unit prices. A complete summary of the scoring is attached to this memorandum.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends award of unit price contracts to Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., Nova Engineering & Environmental, LLC and GeoHydro Engineers, Inc. The term of the contracts will be for one year with two optional annual renewals.
