Subject: Approval of a Design Consultant Contract for the Ashford Dunwoody

**Commuter Trail Phase II Project** 

## **BACKGROUND**

The stated purpose of the Perimeter Community Improvement District's (PCID) Commuter Trail Master Plan is "to identify opportunities to increase transportation options by improving bicycle and pedestrian access to the stations [MARTA] and generally increase mobility for non-motorized users within Peirmeter as well." The city has previously implemented plan recommendations on Crown Pointe Parkway, Central Parkway, Perimeter Center Place and Perimeter Center East. Private development is implementing improvements on Hammond Drive and Perimeter Center West and the PCID is currently developing the design for Phase I of the Ashford Dunwoody commuter trail along the frontage of Perimeter Mall between Hammond Drive and Perimeter Center West. In September the city issued a request for proposals to design the planned Ashford Dunwoody Commuter Trail Phase II project. A total of four proposals were received and evaluated by city and PCID staff based on project understanding, qualifications, experience and cost. Wolverton's proposal was deemed to be the most qualified based on these considerations. After final negotiations Wolverton's cost for the design is \$373,000. With the DeKalb PCID board having committed to provide half of the funding, the city's funding contribution would be up to \$205,000 including a 10% contingency. The proposed funding source is the hotel-motel tax which currently has a balance of approximately \$700,000.

## **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Staff recommends award of a design contract to Wolverton and Associates Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$410,000 including a 10% contingency with half of the costs to be reimbursed by the PCID.
