Subject: Presentation of Ashford Dunwoody Eastbound On Ramp Widening Project by Perimeter CID (PCID)

BACKGROUND

The Perimeter Community Improvement District (PCID) has been working with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) to improve traffic flow onto the eastbound I-285 on-ramp from Ashford Dunwoody Road. As shown in the attached drawing, the proposed improvement consists of adding a lane on the ramp for traffic entering the ramp from the south side of the interchange. Currently the traffic from the south is required to yield at the top of the ramp and merge into the lanes for traffic entering the ramp from the north.

The project is located entirely within GDOT right of way and the state has programmed \$2,000,000 for construction with PCID paying all of the design and management costs. The funding requires a local government sponsor and the PCID is asking Dunwoody to fulfill this role since the project is located within the city limits. As sponsor, Dunwoody would be required to submit customary environmental and utility certifications on behalf of the PCID, advertise for construction bids and contract for the construction. PCID would reimburse the city for any costs incurred.
