- Re-created City 101 (now **Dunwoody 101**) with a focus on being more accessible to citizens who don't have time for a multi-week course. Held May 30, Sept 30. Spring Date – April 17, 2026.
- Created Holiday HQ, branding and promotion efforts with Discover Dunwoody and others.



Public Works

- Project Momentum:
 - Chestnut ES Sidewalk Possible grant funding in pipeline.
 - Dunwoody ES Crosswalk Flashing beacons installed in August.
 - Crosswalk Safety Improvements added at 3 other locations
 - Signs and Striping Replacement \$217K of additional LMIG allocated for sign replacement and striping



Parks

- Project Momentum:
 - Homecoming Park. Funding appropriated (\$5M), bids opening Q1-2026.
 - Wildcat Park Phased Approach.
 - Peachtree Middle School Sod and equipment installed.



Police

- Advanced Technology and Methods:
 - Drone First Responder

Community Development

- Perimeter Circulators. PCID taking lead working with local companies. Applying for a grant from ARC.
- Georgetown Study. Underway, public meeting on January 21, 2026.
- Tree Fund Explainer. Sent to Council July 2025.



Finance

- CIP Review. Done with annual budget process. End product capital funding of \$7.3M.
- Parks: \$5 million for Homecoming Park
- Police: \$800,000 for Flock Safety's drone as first responder program; replacement of gas-powered police vehicles; electric vehicles/Ford Mavericks; ballistic windows on patrol cars; bulletproof vests.



Finance

- Pedestrian Safety: \$500,000 for Dunwoody Village Parkway intersection; audible push buttons at 10 intersections; Vanderlyn at Hensley drives crosswalk bulb outs; Tilly Mill Road at Dunwoody Glen crosswalk realignment; Womack at Vermack roads bulb out
- Sidewalks: \$1,000,000 for Peeler Road sidewalk: Huntington Hall to Equestrian Way; Chamblee Dunwoody Road sidewalk: Spalding Drive to Oakpointe Place; Vermack Road sidewalk: Womack Road to Parliament Drive
