Action

Approval of an agreement with LDDBlueline, Inc. for Design Professional Services for the construction of Homecoming Park.

Details

The city solicited statements of qualification from firms interested in providing Design Professional Services for the construction of Homecoming Park. The selected firm will provide comprehensive professional design services including surveys, geotechnical evaluations, confirming existing site conditions, and finalizing a concept design.

The approved concept will serve as the basis for the preparation of schematic design, design development, and construction documents suitable for permitting. The project delivery method will be Construction Manager at Risk.

Technical responses made up 80% of a firm’s score, with the remaining 20% evaluated based on the submitted project fee. Below are the six submitting firms and their total scores.

Funding for this service, in the amount of \$315,000, will be allocated from General Capital, Project #26B.

The building looks out over the adjacent lake, millhouse, and millpond with the large back porch providing a place to relax and enjoy the views. 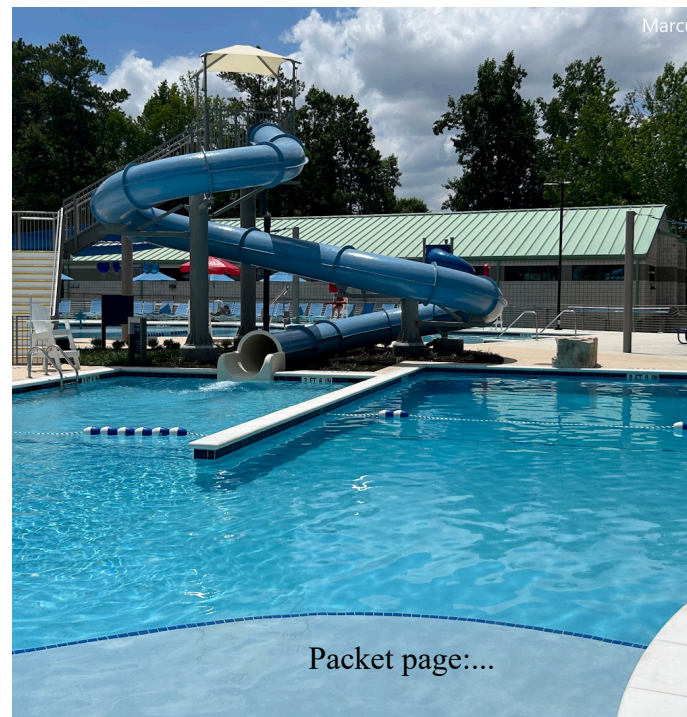

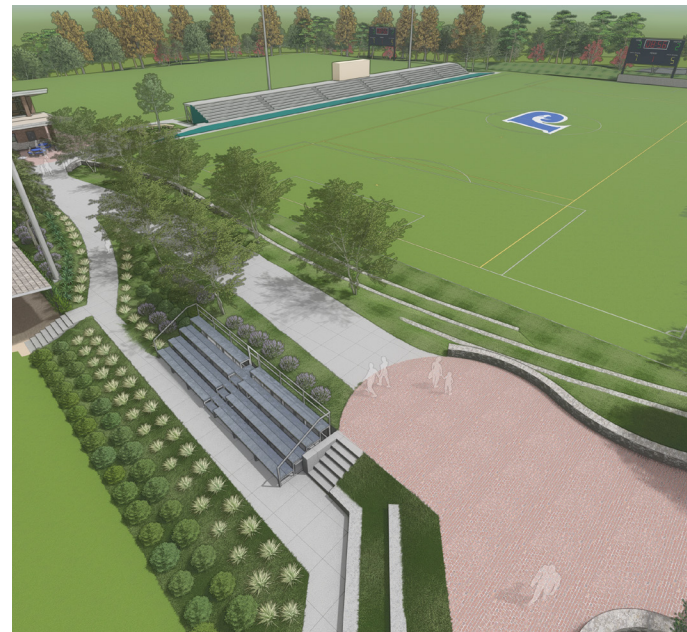

The buildings provided in Phase 1 include restroom pavilions at the roundabout and playground and a restroom building and free-standing pavilion at the Open Lawn. The granite wainscots on the building exteriors connect this new park with the look of existing parks throughout the City while the forms show they are new. Heavy timber is used to emphasize the park feel but translucent fiberglass panels bring a modern look while allowing natural light inside.

The overall project received SITES Silver Certification for sustainability.

Collaborative Budget Control - Designing a facility within a fixed budget is a managed and planned process. The LDDBlueline Team brings extensive experience with the CM-at-Risk delivery method, including the new Dunwoody Maintenance Complex, Cobb County's Milford Recreation Center, and the Marcus Jewish Community Center Renovations. Having the Construction Manager (CM) on board early in the process allows them to understand the development of the project and why certain decisions are made. After verifying that the site and building programs are compatible with the dollars available, the design process proceeds from one phase to the next. "Check and balance" estimates conducted at each phase will involve an open dialogue with the Design team, Dunwoody, CPS, and the CM to discuss possible options to keep the project in budget and moving forward, including the use of add alternates.

DESIGN WITH ACCESSIBILITY

SITE ACCESS AND SAFETY

Some of the first items that the LDDBlueline team discusses during the design process are access and safety, both during construction and after completion. We understand that projects often are adjacent to areas that will be actively used by the public while construction is underway, so minimizing the potential conflict is important. Details of Construction Phasing are coordinated with Dunwoody's staff and the CM to maximum the use of existing facilities if needed during construction activities.

ACCESSIBILITY

LDDBlueline has a process in which our team collaborates with owners to design public buildings that comply with ADA and local accessibility codes. We survey the existing conditions of areas required to be accessible via topographic survey or as-built measurement in order to obtain accurate base data for use

in designing new construction or required modifications. For new facilities, we conduct an internal review for ADA compliance prior to any submittal to permitting authorities. LDDBlueline has worked closely with state and local agencies in developing new facility designs, often including submittal early in the design process to the State ADA Coordinator's for preliminary review. This collaborative effort by all parties during design helps to minimize changes during final inspections and reduce the chance for future legal challenges.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

The City of Dunwoody is located in an EPA zone in Georgia that has a high potential for radon. New structures at Homecoming Park should have a basic under-slab ventilation system to reduce the chance of radon accumulation. Additional testing should be provided by the City to verify the presence of any potentially hazardous materials in the existing structures prior to demolition and to allow the team to include these costs in the overall budget.

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
