Subject: To declare eleven (11) vehicles from the multiple departments as surplus.

Action

Approve the Resolution declaring eleven (11) vehicles from the identified departments as surplus; authorize the City Manager, or designee, to dispose of eight (8) vehicles by public auction; and authorize the transfer of the remaining three (3) vehicles to the Lawrenceville Police Department in exchange for Law Enforcement Precision Immobilization Technique (PIT) training for Dunwoody Police Officers.

Summary

The City has identified eleven (11) vehicles across multiple departments (see Exhibit A) that are no longer needed for City operations.

Recommendation

Approve the resolution declaring eleven City vehicles surplus. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to dispose of eight vehicles through public auction and transfer three vehicles to the Lawrenceville Police Department.

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE PROPERTY SURPLUS; TO PROVIDE A MECHANISM FOR THE TRANSFER AND SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody is authorized to declare property owned by the City as surplus when said property is deemed to be of no further use or value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have identified the items brought forth by City staff to be of no further use to the City and wishes for said property to be disposed of as provided for by Georgia law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dunwoody, Georgia as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Council hereby determine the aforementioned property to be of no further use to the City and, therefore, declares said property to be surplus, suitable for disposal as directed by Georgia Law.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to transfer and sell the vehicles accordingly.
